Conversation Points

- Council discussed additional wages for education above and beyond what the position requires, performance evaluations, longevity, and work experience.
- Council discussed new IT policy. If departments have specific software, they must budget for it.
- No 144 until after budget is set.
- The board agreed to have department heads add 3% on top of 1000 series for the 2021 budgets
- Department heads meet with Council during budget time if they would like to. Council will call department heads if the need to.
