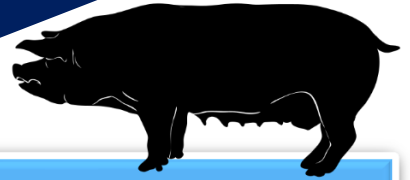

Where will the proceeds go?

As you may know, Golden Meadows Home is a nonprofit Residential Care facility that is owned and operated by Adams County. All of our residents who have mental or physical disabilities need extra help from our caring staff. Their needs vary depending on the extent of their disability. In 1994, we established the Special Needs Resident Fund. This is where all proceeds from this hog roast will be deposited. This fund helps to cover expenses for many medical, recreational and social needs of our residents. We have purchased walkers, eyeglasses, dentures, OTC medications and other medical goods and services that are not always covered by public assistance. We also use some of the funds to help residents remain involved in the community. Many go on outings that include restaurants, ice cream trips and many more. This fund also helps residents who need clothing items or personal care items. To all of us here at Golden Meadows, it's about providing a good quality of life for our residents, as we believe that everyone deserves something to look forward to everyday.
