IN RE: MINUTES

Upon a motion by Cory Sprunger and second by Yvette Weiland, the April 12, 2022 Adams County Council Minutes were approved. Motion carried.

IN RE: EMA DEPARTMENT GRANT

Upon a motion by Fred Velez and second by Cathy Mitchel to approve the three EMA Grants, in the amounts of \$7,820.00; \$8,948.07; \$14,000.75, submitted by John August, EMA Director. Motion Carried.

IN RE: COUNCIL ATTORNEY

County Attorney, Julie-Marie Brown, reported that Council on Aging is seeking \$200,000 from ARPA revenues and introduced Council on Aging Director. Discussion ensued regarding which citizens benefit from this upgrade. Michelle Lengerich, Council on Aging Director, mentioned that residents from all over the county take part in Council on Aging activities. Discussion was held to table this until council has more time to consider. There was discussion about waiting until several requests can be obtained. The matter was tabled until more investigation can be done.

A request form with details on seeking ARPA revenues will be sent to all department heads by the Auditor's office. This will allow a future meeting to be held to discuss all the requests that come in.


Upon a motion by Fred Velez and seconded by John Summers, the above additional appropriations were approved by Council. Motion Carried.
