

The Adams County Board of Commissioners met June 21, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. in the Adams County Service Complex. Present were Commissioners: Stan Stoppenhagen, Rex Moore, Steve Kuhn, Auditor Tony Mellencamp, HR Coordinator, Shannon Greene, and Chief Deputy Auditor, Brianna Brodbeck.

IN RE: MINUTES

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and seconded by Steve Kuhn, for approval by the County Board of Commissioners' Minutes for June 14, 2022. Motion Carried.

IN RE: AUDITOR REPORT

Weights and Measures

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve the entry of the Weights and Measures report from May 16 to June 15, submitted by Inspector, Dan Hackman. Motion Carried.

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve the Annual Weights and Measures Report submitted by Inspector, Dan Hackman. Motion Carried.

Allied Weekly Claims

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Rex Moore to approve the Accounts Payable Claims to be paid on 6-22-22 in the amount of \$429,397.67. Motion Carried.

Eastern Alliance

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Rex Moore to approve a claim for Eastern Alliance for Worker's Comp audit, in the amount of \$2,538.00. Motion Carried.

Elaine Shafley

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve the monthly claim for Elaine Shafley for health insurance consulting, in the amount of \$2,916.67. Motion Carried.

IN RE: BUILDING AND GROUNDS

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve a claim to Myers Heating and Plumbing for work in the power room in the Service Complex, to be paid out of fund 1138, In the amount of \$9,677.00. Motion Carried.

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve a quote of \$2,858.20 to BSecure Alarm Systems, to install new LED lights in the basement floor of the Complex. This would be paid out of fund 1138. Motion Carried.

Burkhalter informed the Commissioners he is seeking quotes to replace the elevators in the Adams County Courthouse and Service Complex.

IN RE: HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

Brad Yoder, Superintendent, informed the Commissioners that Jason Nussbaum would like to have use of the county parking lot during the 4H Fair.

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve use of the county parking lot during the 4-H Fair. Motion Carried.

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Rex Moore to approve two right of way permits for AEP, both in the north end of the county, to replace utility poles. Motion Carried. One pole location is in Root Township while the other is in Union Township.

Yoder noted the highway department will be finishing up dust control and will soon begin chip and seal.

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve accepting the MVH and LR&S revenues into the highway funds. These were the June draws. The MVH amount for June was \$284,663.55 and LR&S amount was \$43,662.48. Motion Carried. These amounts have nothing to do with the price of gasoline, but the gallons sold, regardless of the gas prices, according to Brad Yoder.

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Rex Moore to approve the Monthly report for Building and Planning, submitted by Director, Mark Wynn, being entered into the record. Motion Carried.

IN RE: TREASURER

Treasurer Dyer noted that tax collections are going very well. He also reminded them that there are 60 parcels ready for tax sale at this point. He has some ideas on investments and will discuss these with the Auditor's office.

IN RE: OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY PRESENTED




IN RE: COUNTY ATTORNEY


IN RE: ADJOURNMENT
