IN RE: MINUTES

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and seconded by Steve Kuhn, for approval by the County Board of Commissioners' Minutes for June 21, 2022. Motion Carried.

The commissioners discussed with Rick Burkhalter, Building and Grounds, a BMV kiosk possibly being installed in a county building. This would aid the courts. It was advised that Judge Sam Conrad bring the subject to the IT Steering Committee.


