

The Adams County Board of Commissioners met July 5, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. in the Adams County Service Complex. Present were Commissioners: Stan Stoppenhagen, Rex Moore, Steve Kuhn, Auditor Tony Mellencamp, and HR Coordinator, Shannon Greene.

IN RE: MINUTES

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and seconded by Steve Kuhn, for approval by the County Board of Commissioners' Minutes for June 28, 2022. Motion Carried.

IN RE: AUDITOR REPORT

Payroll Claims

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve the Payroll Claims for June 24, in the amount of \$332,237.47. Motion Carried.

Accounts Payable Claims

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Rex Moore to approve the Accounts Payable Claims to be paid on 7-6-22, in the amount of \$487,226.79. Motion Carried.

Allied Insurance Weekly Claims

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve the Allied Health Insurance Weekly Claims in the amount of \$65,894.01. Motion Carried.

IN RE: BUILDING AND GROUNDS

Rick Burkhalter updated the Commissioners on work being done at the Service Complex, including an air unit being installed in the Health Clinic, in order to protect vaccines if the power goes out.

Burkhalter noted that work is continuing on the power room in the Service complex.

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Rex Moore to approve \$9600.00 for labor to complete the 1st phase of the power room work, to SC Construction. Motion Carried. This will be paid from fund 1138.

IN RE: HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Rex Moore to approve a bid submitted by Jutte Excavating, for scouring three bridges, numbers 150,152, and 501 for \$243,000.00. Motion Carried.

IN RE: BUILDING AND PLANNING

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Rex Moore to approve the Bryan Family Farms Subdivision / Hartford Sec 28 / 2 Lots / Located on CR1100S, west of CR 650W. Motion Carried.

IN RE: TREASURER

Treasurer Dyer informed the commissioners that the number of parcels in tax sale is now down to 23, from an original number of 60. He noted the tax collections are nearing 99% at the current time. This is due, in part, to Kathleen LaFontaine sending courtesy letters to taxpayers who are delinquent.

IN RE: OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY PRESENTED


There was nothing under other matters.


