IN RE: MINUTES

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and seconded by Steve Kuhn, for approval by the County Board of Commissioners' Minutes for November 22, 2022. Motion Carried.

IN RE: AUDITOR REPORT

Allied Weekly Claims

Upon a motion by Rex Moore and second by Steve Kuhn to approve the Allied Weekly Health Insurance Claims in the amount of \$24,237.11. Motion Carried.

IN RE: BUILDING AND GROUNDS

Director Rick Burkhalter reported that the chillers are now installed in the Adams County Service Complex. 
IN RE: COUNTY ATTORNEY

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Rex Moore to adjourn. Motion Carried.


