IN RE: MINUTES

Upon a motion by Steve Bailey and seconded by Steve Kuhn for approval by the County Board of Commissioners' Minutes for June 4, 2024. Motion Carried.

IN RE: AUDITOR REPORT

Eastern Alliance Claims

Buildings and Grounds Manager discussed various activities around the county.

Motion Carried. American Elevator is the company that installed it and will service it.

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Steve Bailey to approve a service contract on the chiller, from the Dilling Group, at a cost of \$6,557.00 for one year. Motion Carried.

IN RE: HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT AND COUNTY ENGINEER

County Engineer, Nate Rumschlag, reported on activities with his office.

Upon a motion by Steve Bailey and second by Steve Kuhn to approve the low bid of \$53,922.00 for Bridge #40, to Pioneer Associates. Motion Carried.

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Steve Bailey to approve the low bid of \$36,058.00 to RL McCoy for Bridge #44. Motion Carried.

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Steve Bailey to approve a grant application from INDOT for bridge overlay. Motion Carried.

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Steve Bailey to approve a grant application for a Community Crossings Grant for bridge work. Motion Carried.

Upon a motion by Steve Kuhn and second by Steve Bailey to approve the low bid received from Brooks Construction for work which was approved via the Community Crossings Grant. The bid was \$1,900,551.00 There are four areas under the whole grant. Motion Carried.
