SHORT TITLE: A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, COUNTY OF ADAMS, STATE OF INDIANA, WHICH DESIGNATES LEGAL HOLIDAYS TO BE OBSERVED BY COUNTY OFFICES DURING CALENDAR YEAR 2025.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has the authority to establish those holidays which shall be observed by County Offices as legal holidays;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Board of Commissioners, County of Adams, and State of Indiana hereby declares the following dates as legal holidays during the calendar year 2025:

NOVEMBER 11	TUESDAY, VETERAN'S DAY
NOVEMBER 27, 28	THURSDAY & FRIDAY, THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY
DECEMBER 24	WEDNESDAY, CHRISTMAS EVE
DECEMBER 25	THURSDAY, CHRISTMAS DAY
DECEMBER 31	WEDNESDAY, NEW YEARS EVE

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such holidays shall be considered paid holidays for all County employees and all County offices shall be closed to the general public on such holidays unless the Board of Commissioners authorizes a County office to remain open on a legal holiday, in which case the employees of said County office shall be compensated in accordance with the County Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual.




