
IN RE: OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY PRESENTED

There were discussions held with Sheriff Dan Mawhorr. He and HR Coordinator, Shannon Greene, brought up a future ask in that for K-9 officers, who are required to be paid an extra half hour for caring for their canine partners each day. Instead of paying them with paid time off it was discussed paying them actual time at a cost of \$11,000.00 per year, which is less than covering shifts all year for the paid time off. They will come back next month on this.


The Sheriff also discussed some plumbing issues that will still need to be fixed at the jail. He also noted he would like an executive session to discuss security issues.
