Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and seconded by Stan Stoppenhagen for approval by the County Board of Commissioners' Minutes for May 6, 2025. Motion Carried.

**Animal Control Report**

IT Director, Mike Brown, discussed Microsoft licensing with Commissioners.


**IN RE:** COUNTY ATTORNEY


**IN RE:** ADJOURNMENT
