

The Adams County Board of Commissioners met June 10, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. in the Adams County Service Complex. Present were Commissioners: Steve Bailey, Doug Bauman, Attorney, Mark Burry, Attorney, Clayton Lengerich, HR Coordinator, Shannon Greene, Auditor, Tony Mellencamp. Stan Stoppenhagen was not present.

IN RE: MINUTES

Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and seconded by Steve Bailey for approval by the County Board of Commissioners' Minutes for June 3, 2025. Motion Carried.

IN RE: AUDITOR REPORT

Accounts Payable Claims

Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and second by Steve Bailey to approve the Accounts Payable Claims in the amount of \$1,289,711.45. Motion Carried.

Eastern Alliance Claims

Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and second by Steve Bailey to approve the Eastern Alliance claims in the amount of \$525.15. Motion Carried.

Allied Insurance Claims

Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and second by Steve Bailey to approve the Allied Weekly Health Insurance Claims in the amount of \$5,599.12. Motion Carried. The Auditor verified claimants.

Buildings and Grounds Manager, Rick Burkhalter, was present to provide the Commissioners with an update on various projects his department has been involved with.

Highway Superintendent, Brad Yoder, provided reports to the Commissioners.

Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and second by Steve Bailey to approve a right of way permit to I&M to replace poles at CR150W and CR800S and CR 850S. Motion Carried.

Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and second by Steve Bailey to give permission to the Highway Department to utilize the equipment they had been given permission to order several months ago. Motion Carried.

IN RE: BUILDING AND PLANNING

Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and second by Steve Bailey to approve Becker Subdivision / Root Sec 30 / 2 Lots / Located on the NW corner of CR750N and CR 200W. Motion Carried.

Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and second by Steve Bailey to approve Replat of Lot 1A of the Replat of Oakdust Subdivision / Root Sec 30 / 2 Lots / Located on CR200W, South of CR 750N. Motion Carried.

IN RE: HR COORDINATOR

Upon a motion by Doug Bauman and second by Steve Bailey to approve a two week, every five year pay, since they are out of FMLA. Motion Carried.

IN RE: OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY PRESENTED

There was discussion about fiber optic being placed down Winchester Rd. There is concern it may be a private utility and would need approval with landowners, and that the Commissioners had no standing to approve or deny the private utility.

Public Health Nurse, Holli Degitz, presented Commissioners with a plan to take two part-time nurse positions and create one full-time nurse. If this would be approved by Commissioners the Council would have to approve the funding.

There was some discussion from Dave Sovine regarding a fence that was placed with concern it could lead to traffic accidents. Brad Yoder, Highway Department, noted the fence is within legal requirements at this time.




