Each department would be given a line for IT purchases, which would be zero the first year but then will be budgeted starting in 2027, with help from the IT Director.



Upon a motion by Bob Rhoades and second by Fred Velez to move the Council Budget Workshop to Friday, August 22, 8 a.m. Motion Carried.


