



ADAMS COUNTY DRUG COURT LOCAL RULE

LR01-AR00-02 PROBLEM-SOLVING COURTS

Those persons directed to participate in the Adams County Drug Court may be assessed in accordance with the following Schedule of Fees pursuant to the authority granted by the Indiana Problem Solving Courts Statutes (Indiana Code 33-23-16 et.al.) and the Indiana Problem-Solving Court Rules:

1. A Drug Court administration fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per participant payable to the Adams County Clerk.
2. A Drug Court user fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month, beginning on the second month of participation for every month that an individual participates in Drug Court, payable to the Adams County Clerk.
3. A Drug Court chemical testing fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per week payable to the Adams County Clerk.
4. A Drug Court chemical testing confirmation fee ranging from fifteen dollars (\$15.00) to ninety-five dollars (\$95.00) payable to the Adams County Clerk.
5. A Drug Court transfer fee of \$25.00 per participant per transfer, payable to the Adams County Clerk, waived for participants transferred from the Adams Circuit Court.
6. Substance use disorder services, mental health services, and general health services as set by the providers and payable to the entity providing the service.
7. Program fees such as Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT), one hundred dollars (\$100.00), payable to the Adams County Clerk.
8. Fees due to sanctions, such as:
 - a. Home detention/electronic monitoring at a cost of ten dollars (\$10.00) per day for Adams County residents, payable to the Adams County Clerk.
 - b. Work Release at a cost of:
 - i. Initial Processing fee of twenty five dollars (\$25.00), payable to the Adams County Clerk;
 - ii. Administrative and Advance fee of three hundred thirty six dollars (\$336.00), payable to the Adams County Detention Center; and

- iii. Room and Board and GPS Monitoring fee of one hundred sixty eight dollars (\$168.00) per week (at a minimum) commencing the second week of Work Release, payable to the Adams County Detention Center.
9. Residents of counties other than Adams are typically monitored by Wells County Community Corrections (WCCC). WCCC sets and collects their own fees.

- ~~A. Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court shall be assessed an administration fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) upon admission into the program.~~
- ~~B. Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court shall be assessed a monthly user fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) beginning with the second month of participation and for each month thereafter for the duration of their participation in the program.~~
- ~~C. Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court shall be responsible for all chemical testing fees. Participants shall be responsible for the cost of any confirmatory test.~~
- ~~D. Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court but transferred to another Indiana Drug Court are assessed a transfer fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), payable at the time of transfer.~~
- ~~E. Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court from another Indiana Drug Court are assessed a transfer fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00). These participants are assessed a monthly user fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) beginning the second month of involvement and for each month thereafter for the duration of their participation in the Adams County Drug Court.~~
- ~~F. All fees assessed herein in subsections A-E are due and payable to the Adams County Clerk's Office.~~
- ~~G. Participants admitted to the Adams County Drug Court will be assessed a fee for substance abuse services received as a result of referrals made by the Court, and participants may be further assessed fees for mental health services, other health services, and monitoring services received as a result of referrals made by the Court. Fees for these services are payable to the entity providing the service.~~
