IN RE: MINUTES

#### **Roads**

Highway Superintendent, Lonnie Caffee, reported #53 stone has been spread on county road 850 S between 300 S and State Road 116. Also, they are half way completed on spreading #53 stone on county road 750 S, then #73 stone will be spread which will bring closure for winter grading. The department is applying winter mix to potholes at the south half of the county,

The contract with Low & Associates for the new financials program was submitted for signature.


Upon a motion Rex Moore, seconded by Kim Fruechte, approval to sign the contract with Low & Associates subject to appropriation by County Council. Motion carried.




Upon a motion by Kim Fruechte, seconded Rex Moore, the meeting for October 30, 2018 was adjourned. Motion carried.
